### **JOHNE'S DECLARATION**

Exhibitors will be allocated separate bedding and wash area in accordance with recommended guidelines.

**Declaration is to be submitted by closing date of entries.**

**Johne's Disease:** Wagga Wagga Showground is located in a Bovine Johne's Disease Protected Zone. No cattle may be exhibited from any herd & property unless they meet the requirements of N.S.W. Agriculture for entry to a protected. Cattle must either:

- Originate from assessed herds (i.e. tested and accredited) under the Cattle JDMAP with a status of MN1, MN2, or MN3. Such cattle may originate from control or protected or free zones OR
- Originate from assessed herds in a protected or protected or free zone (currently 04/7/00 W.A, N.T, QLD, parts of N.S.W and northern pastoral lease area of S.A.) OR
- Originate from a "check tested" herd in a control area (all of S.A. except the northern pastoral lease area, all of Victoria, the N.S.W. Rural Lands Protection Boards of Murray, Riverina, South Coast, Tweed, Lismore and Casino)

**Note:** - Check testing is a test of 50 head by an approved practitioner.  
- Individual movement tests are not acceptable for movements from control areas to this area or show.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**SECURITY OF ANIMALS:** All male exhibits of Beef and Dual Purpose Cattle born on or before 1st October 2008 shall be ringed through the nose and at all times to be led by such ring.

**HANDLING:** All cattle must be tied up in their stalls and led out to the ring. If not led, they will not be judged.

**AGE OF EXHIBITS:** The age of Beef Cattle to be actual age up to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2011

**TIMES:** Beef Cattle must be penned by 8.30am on Friday. Judging will commence at 9.30 am.

**SCHEDULE:** A standard schedule is provided for ANGUS, HEREFORDS, MURRAY GREYS, RED POLLS, POLL HEREFORDS, SANTA GERTRUDIS, SIMMENTALS, CHAROLAIS, MAINE ANJOU, GALLOWSAYS, LIMOUSIN, LOWLINES, SQUARE METERS and any other registered breed included as under.

BEDDING FOR STOCK WILL BE PROVIDED.

STALLING ALLOCATIONS WILL BE MARKED.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO ADVISE BREED OF CATTLE ON ENTRY FORM.
