**ENTRIES CLOSE ON FRIDAY, 23rd September 2011**

### **STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS**

Exhibits in the Horticulture Classes MAY be delivered to Hammond Hall on Wednesday **28<sup>th</sup> September 2011 between the hours of 3 pm OR no later than 5 pm. Or on the morning of the Show (Thursday) 29th September 2011 no later than 8.30 am ready for judging at 9 am.**

Exhibits must be staged in the position allotted by the staging committee.

All articles for competition or otherwise must be legibly and correctly named on Society's label. **Advertising cards. etc., are NOT ALLOWED.** Embellishments ALLOWED. No table ornament, or bouquet of any description, shall be made in the hall, except on the tables specially provided for the purpose.

No exhibit will be allowed to be removed during the time of the Show. **The Hammond Hall will re-open at 9.30am to 12pm Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011 for collection of exhibits.**

**No exhibitor shall remove entries from show cases unless accompanied by a steward  
THIS RULE WILL BE STRICKLY ENFORCED**

All flowers etc., shall be considered the property of the Committee until 9.30am Saturday when they will, on production of a card enclosed with entry tickets, be delivered up to the Exhibitor. The Committee will not be responsible for any loss or accident or damage to any exhibit.

No protests will be entertained unless they are made in **writing** and lodged with the Secretary before 12 noon on the day of Judging.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitors in these classes to supply their own stand or vase.

All spikes should be legibly labelled with correct name of plant.

Exhibitors name to be entered under and on the bottom of stand (on label supplied by the Show Society)

## CUT FLOWERS

All flowers in the Cut Flowers Section to be grown by exhibitor. To be judged for quality and to be shown in containers which are to be supplied by the exhibitor. 'Distinct' means 'Different'. 'NND' means Not Necessary Distinct. A VASE is a container whose height must be more than its diameter (Diameter is measured 4cm from the top of the vase). Diameter must not exceed 9cm. A BOWL is a circular container whose diameter measured across the top is more than the height.
