First Heat.For A and B grade horses. To be tried over two rounds, lowest aggregate of faults in the two rounds shall decide the winner. A Jump off in the case of equality of faults for first place; the horses concerned shall jump off twice if necessary, over a reduced course of obstacles on increased height and/or width. If still an equality of faults, then a further jump off shall decide the fastest time.

GENERAL RULES:

Winner is the one with the highest total points. Workout as per new rules, jump height, minimum 1.mtr to 1.1mtr.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00

PRIZEMONEY. as follows:

First, \$50.00 plus Sash; Second, \$20.00 plus Sash, Third, \$15.00 plus Sash; Fourth, \$10.00 plus Sash; Fifth \$5.00 plus Sash; Sixth, Sash.

NOTE-.Any Saddlery, Equipment and Dress allowed under E.A./F.E.I. Rules is acceptable to be used for the Junior Equitation Competition.

USE OF HORSES:

A rider may compete on more than one horse per class, but may only place on the nominated horse which must be ridden first.

PREVIOUS QUALIFIERS:

Previous qualifiers may compete again, and will be eligible to receive prize money and sashes. If they win again however, the next place getter in the round will qualify to compete in the Final.
