ARTS, CRAFTS AND COOKING

Rules and Conditions for Albernie Honour Board. Selection of 10 Articles from following Sections:- Cooking, Handcrafts, Knitting, Crochet, Sewing, Needlework, Floral Art and Art.

Entry Fee: \$6.00 per branch.

Please Note: Tickets to be attached to each item stating Section to which they are to be judged, e.g., Embroidery, Knitting, etc.

Maximum of 100 points awarded for each article - minimum 60 points.

All work must be done by C.W.A. Members and to be labelled JUNIOR AND AGE (where applicable).

Individual items may be covered with transparent covers by exhibitors. Branch names to be included in display before judging. Articles must be taken to judging table.

Articles must be contained at all times in each Branch's Court, but 60cm of floor space in front of Court may be used. Courts to be drawn for.

Entry tickets provided by the Wagga Wagga Show Society to be attached to each article. Points awarded will be written there on.

Branches may bring material on morning of judging day, Wednesday 28th September 2011 but all exhibits must be ready for judging by 11 am.

"Courts must be arranged for judging immediately after the completion of the judging of the articles." Each Branch is limited to two members to arrange display and all other members other than Stewarts must leave the hall during judging..

Branches may place approximately 6 items of embellishment during judging and may commence arrangements at Branch's discretion from 8 am on judging day.

Artistic decorations permitted for display. Power available if required. FINISHED DISPLAY 180cm WIDE, BENCH TOP 120cm, BACK WALL 163cm, ABOVE BENCH: DISPLAY TABLE TO BE FLOOR LEVEL 83cm, FRONT FLOOR DISPLAY 80cm NAME BANNER TO BE DISPLAYED.

TROPHY FOR MOST ORIGINAL EXHIBIT, donated by Mrs. L. Lucas (in Perpetuity), to be judged separately.

The Branch winning the greatest number of points each year will receive the Grace Alberni Honour Board to be held for 12 months and then returned to the Show Society for further competition one month prior to Show.

The Brunskill-Bryson Rose Bowl, will be awarded for the Best Display by a Branch. Ownership of this trophy shall not pass to the winning Branch each year, but shall remain the Society's property. The name of the winning Branch each year will be engraved on the Trophy. This Trophy will be judged separately.

Lydia Lucas Rose Bowl (in Perpetuity) will be awarded to the Branch for the Most Attractive Name Banner.

The Society's Pennants for First, Second and Third placing in overall points scored will be awarded, also prize money of: First, \$25.00 Second, \$15.00 Third, \$10.00 donated by -
